How fines work

- Single parent
- 1 child
- 1 week holiday or 5 unauthorised days or 10 unauthorised lates



- Your holiday will not be authorised and you must speak to the school before booking anything.
- Because your child will miss 5 days of school, you will be given a penalty notice fine.

reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days

Penalty notice fine for each child

- You will receive a penalty notice fine for EVERY child you take away in term time.
- You do NOT just receive one fine per family.

reduced to £320 if paid within 21 days

Each parent/carer receives a fine



£160 + £160 + £160 + £160

3rd ABSENCE (in 3 years)

- A penalty notice fine will not be given.

- Instead, your case will be taken to court.

- A magistrate can fine each parent **£2500** for each child.

Attendance reminder - A fine for school absences will be £80 if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days. In the case of repeated fines, if a parent receives a second fine for the same child within any three-year period, this will be charged at the higher rate of £160.

Fines per parent will be capped to two fines within any three-year period. Once this limit has been reached, other action like a parenting order or prosecution will be considered. If you're prosecuted and attend court because your child hasn't been attending school, you could get a fine of up to £2,500.

The vast majority of fines for unauthorised absence (89%) are issued for term time holidays.

Regular absence = Possible prosecution

The new rules mean that offences are looked at over a 3 year period, so for example, if you take unauthorised leave every year, on the third year your case will be automatically referred to court.
