Congratulations to Josh who was received player of the tournament from Mr Taylor.



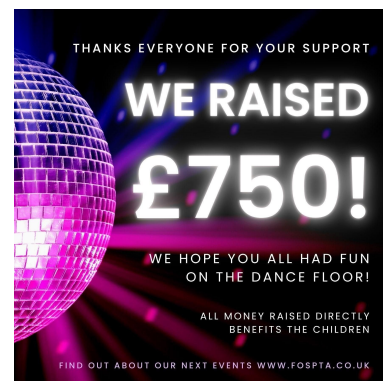
SAFE
