Social Services EXPLAINED PART 2 CHILD IN NEED

A SIMPLE GUIDE FOR PARENTS

OUR SERIES - STEP BY STEP

A Child in Need plan is put in place when professionals believe a child needs extra support to maintain a reasonable level of health or development.

It is meant to be **SUPPORTIVE**, not **punitive**. It does **NOT** automatically mean your children are going to be removed.

PART 3 TOMORROW: CHILD PROTECTION

WHAT IS A CHILD IN NEED?

- It is there to support families who may be struggling with:
- Mental health
- Domestic abuse in the home
- School attendance issues
- Behavioural struggles
- Parenting difficulties
- Housing problems
- Disability or additional needs
- Family breakdown or stress
- Emotional wellbeing

A social worker will usually complete an assessment and there may be a Child in Need meeting with professionals involved with the family.

This could include:

- School
- Health visitors
- Mental health services
- Support workers
- Sometimes police

A plan is created together with goals and support.

WHAT SHOULD A SOCIAL WORKER BE DOING?

- Explain concerns clearly
- Listen to your side
- Be honest about a parent
- Offer support and guidance
- Keep communication professional
- Work with the family where possible

You have the right to understand what the concerns are, what is expected and what support is available. Ask questions.

WHAT IF THINGS WORSEN ABOUT YOU ARE WRITTEN?

- You can:
- Challenge interventions
- Ask for corrections
- Send your own written responses
- Ask for copies of reports and plans
- Keep your own records

Do it calmly and factually - it makes a bigger difference.

CAN YOU HAVE SUPPORT IN MEETINGS?

Yes. You can ask to bring:

- An advocate
- A friend or family member
- A support worker
- A scribe in some situations

You do not have to walk into meetings alone feeling fearful.

MY HONEST ADVICE

Don't bury your head in the sand. Try to:

- Engage
- Communicate
- Ask for help if needed
- Keep records
- Stay calm even when emotional

Patience and avoidance usually make professionals more worried, not less.
