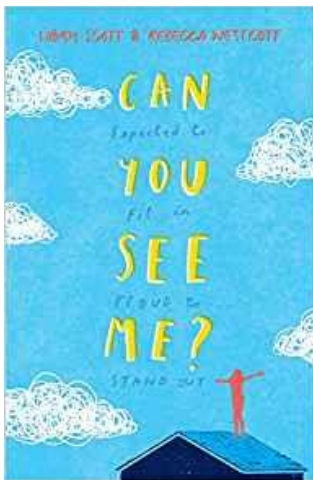

Libby Scott

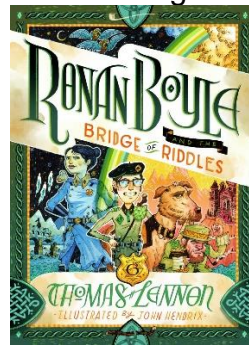
